CALL FOR PARTICIPATION

The IN2PAST National Researcher Meetings have become a well-established tradition of this Associated Laboratory, promoting the sharing and discussion of research conducted across its five thematic areas. These annual meetings have been strengthening the connection between different perspectives on the preservation, knowledge, and configuration of the past, its integration into territories, and its relationship with public policies, serving as a central space for interdisciplinary dialogue among researchers from the various research units that make up IN2PAST.

The 6th IN2PAST National Meeting, to be held in September 2026, is once again marked by the cross-cutting nature of research lines and by a more inclusive plenary participation, consolidating the collaborative and integrative model previously introduced. Thus, this edition aims to strengthen collaborative dynamics, stimulate interdisciplinary approaches, and foster the collective construction of knowledge within the IN2PAST community.

We invite researchers and doctoral candidates from the seven research units (UID) that make up IN2PAST – CESEM, CHAIA, CRIA, HERCULES, IHC, IHA, and Lab2PT – to submit individual or group poster proposals related to ongoing research projects that fall within the scope and objectives of one or more of the aforementioned IN2PAST thematic areas, which can be consulted at <https://in2past.org/thematic-lines/>.

The poster proposal should include the following items:

- Name(s) and surname(s) of the author(s)
- Institutional affiliation (UID + University or Department)
- Whether the author is an integrated researcher or a PhD candidate
- Brief CV of the author(s) (max. 100 words)
- Poster title
- Poster abstract (max. 200 words)
- Indication of the IN2PAST research lines (LT) to which the proposal relates

The requested elements are intended solely for the scientific evaluation of the proposal and do not require a rigid graphic template; we encourage approaches that highlight the poster as a tool for visual and conceptual communication, featuring concise designs with a strong visual component.

Each session of the scientific meeting will feature two moderators and two discussants from different research lines or UIDs, as well as six participants from diverse fields, in order to ensure an interdisciplinary approach. Posters will be assigned to thematic sessions based on their relevance, displayed on paper in a common area, and presented in each session in the form of “flash presentations.” The structure of each session includes an introduction and presentation of the posters, followed by a discussion of three cross-cutting issues, a discussion of specific questions, and, finally, a broader discussion with

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all researchers and the audience, promoting the exchange of ideas and scientific dialogue.

The meeting notice and agenda for the IN2PAST Scientific Council Plenary Meeting will be sent in a timely manner to all affiliated researchers and PhD graduates.
